We are pleased to announce that the 18th International Meeting on Boron Chemistry (IMEBoron-18) will be held at the Ookayama Campus of the Institute of Science Tokyo from September 6 (Sunday) to September 10 (Thursday), 2026. This international conference will focus on the molecular science of boron, bringing together participants from a wide range of fields, from fundamental to applied chemistry. Boron chemistry covers a broad spectrum of disciplines, including organic, inorganic, organometallic, physical, coordination, biological, medicinal, natural products, industrial, and materials chemistry. In recent years, boron chemistry has also gained increasing attention for its promising applications in areas such as organic light-emitting diodes (OLEDs) and boron neutron capture therapy (BNCT).

The conference has a long history, dating back to its first edition in 1971. Over the years, it has hosted highly distinguished participants, including three Nobel Laureates in Chemistry: Professor Akira Suzuki (Hokkaido University), Professor Herbert C. Brown (Purdue University), and Professor William Lipscomb (Harvard University). The meeting has consistently provided a platform for high-level scientific discussions. In Japan, boron chemistry has been advanced by many researchers, including the members of the organizing committee. The forthcoming IMEBoron-18 will be the first time in twenty years since the conference was last held in Japan (Sendai, 2005, hosted by Professor Yoshinori Yamamoto of Tohoku University). We believe that hosting the conference again in Japan is timely and significant.

The 18th IMEBoron is not only of great academic importance but is also expected to contribute significantly to pharmaceuticals, materials chemistry, and advanced measurement sciences in Japan.
